Current HOA Dues

Dues include year around maintenance of the roads, water system, gate, etc. Dues also include water purchased under a Surplus Water Contract that the HOA has with Salt Lake City Corporation.

Cabins: Discounted Rate if postmarked on or before December 15th - \$981.00 Lots: Discounted Rate if postmarked on or before December 15th - \$490.50

Cabins: Standard Rate when postmarked on or before December 31st - \$1090.00 Lots: Standard Rate when postmarked on or before December 31st - \$545.00

Dues received after January 1st will be subject to a \$25/month late fee plus 18%annual interest

Gate Access

To access gate, our gate keeper programs new owners' cell phones to open the gate. When a lot or cabin is sold the seller should provide the new owner with a key FOB and a hard key to the gate. If that doesn't happen our gate keeper will give a new member a FOB key for when the gate computer may not be working or if the new member doesn't have a cell phone. He will also provide a hard key for the padlock to be used when the electricity is down.

Utilities

Water - As stated above the HOA is under contract for Surplus Water from Salt Lake City Corporation. The HOA owns and maintains all infracstrure associated with the water system, waterlines, tanks, etc. and we have a contracted water master who monitors and conducts state mandated tests. If required the HOA secretary will provide a water letter upon request.

Electricity – Rocky Mountain Power will be your provider. 877.508.5088

Garbage – There is no curbside garbage collection in Big Cottonwood Canyon. However, - \$490.50 every property owner receives a bill from Wasatch Front Waste and Recycling District for dumpsters that are located at the Brighton Loop or in the Silverfork

area. As a canyon resident you are entitled to one free green waste or household waste dumpster to be brought on your property for 3-4 days during the summer. 385.468.6325
